The UAW-LETC Program is proud to have 265 students from 55 Job Corps Centers in our program. Your students can benefit from Advanced Training and the vast opportunities available to them in the Automotive, Diesel or Collision Repair and Refinishing areas.

UAW-LETC at Clearfield Job Corps Center is in the process of upgrading the class curriculum for each area of the program. These upgrades include all of the Automotive classes, Diesel Technology, and Collision Repair and Refinishing. These ongoing Automotive improvements will offer new and current students to the program the opportunity to obtain state-of-the-art training on late model Toyota and Lexus vehicles. The current vehicle inventory includes: 2010-2014 Camrys, 2008-2013 Corollas, 2009 Tundras, 2009-2012 Prius and 2008-2011 Lexus vehicles. These automobiles are used in every area of our program, offering students a wide range of hands-on training, utilizing system faults

for increased diagnostic skills development. In our Diesel Program, training is offered utilizing current industry standards, on late model training aides and medium heavy duty trucks. In both the Automotive and Diesel Programs, UAW offers in-depth instruction, lab settings and Work-Based-Learning (WBL) opportunities. WBL partners include: Toyota, Lexus, Ford, Chrysler, General Motors, Nissan, Honda and after-markets. Diesel students do WBL at Swift Trucking, Utah Transit Authority, Utah Department of Transportation, and many others.

UAW’s partnership with Toyota provides a large number of advantages to the students that successfully complete T-TEN training in the form of cars, training aides and resources toward training. Toyota recently announced another benefit for our full program graduates. This benefit involves work experience credit toward the two year ASE certification requirement. Toyota has established a process to ensure that ASE’s two year work experience is properly credited to each T-TEN graduate’s ASE account. While granting such credit for graduates of an OEM program like T-TEN, this advantage will ensure future success for our graduates entering the automotive workforce upon graduation.

In addition to this new procedure for recording ASE certification, UAW has established a procedure in which more students will take and pass ASE tests. In fact, the current ASE pass rate for this year is well over 70%. Our students are having success passing tests in all 8 automotive areas.

Several other benefits from our Toyota Partnership was the donation of five 2013 and 2014 vehicles and the donation of 35 engines and transmissions for our classes. These donations will benefit our current students and all students considering the UAW-LETC Toyota program at Clearfield Job Corps Center for Advanced Training.
